4 apartments; \$1,450 addition

"addition on Claremont side, 8 feet by 28 feet, two stories."
[Was this addition built along Claremont? Or was it actually an extension to the rear of the 1922 addition?]

contractor: F. Young
addition to the "Clareton Apartments"

"Close present door from dining room to bedroom. Replace in new opening from same room to rear hall and back entrance."

Building Permit #74553, 8 JANUARY 1954

\$1,500 alteration

"back porch to be part of kitchen for breakfast area; add bathroom between dining room and hall."
